Monday March 26<sup>th</sup> and Friday March 30<sup>th</sup>.

## Leaves / Limbs / Old Plants

If you have not already removed any leaves, limbs and old plants from your campsite, please take any of these items to one of the designated locations that we use to dump them. PLEASE DO NOT DUMP any of these items in ANY side ditches, roads, grassy areas, dumpsters or fields.

## Maintenance Tip

Clean your 30Amp camper plug before the season. If you will scrape or wire brush the prongs on your camper plug, it will make better contact in the power box. This will enable better contact and reduce the possibility of overheating your connector.

## Vacuum Breakers

Please DO NOT ALTER or REMOVE the Vacuum Breaker from the hose bibb at your campsite. These breakers are required by county code. If you feel there is a problem with the vacuum breaker at your site, please let us know so we can repair or replace it. If we find a site without a breaker, we will impose a replacement fee and you will be invoiced for it.

## Campsite Appearance

A cordial reminder that campsites must be kept neat and in good order. Keep grass mowed, leaves / trash picked up, and decks in good repair.

## Golf Cart Violations

Our Golf Cart rules are for the safety of our customers and guests. Some of the major issues we had in the past are: Underage drivers, excessive speed, driving in restricted areas, and golf carts being driven after 11pm. Please go over the Golf Cart Rules with your family and guest. During cart inspections, you will receive and sign a copy of the Golf Cart Rules for your cart(s). The rules are also posted on our website, our Facebook page, and at the office. PLEASE take these rules seriously and follow them, your golf cart privileges here at Homeplace depends on it.

## Get your Golf Cart Registered AND Pool Passes Early!!

Golf Cart AND Pool Pass ID Registrations will begin on May 5<sup>th</sup> and be held each Saturday after that. Times will be posted at the office gate. Please make an effort to have your cart(s) registered and Pool Pass ID made before the pool opens! This is also a great time to add any Extra Person(s) that will need a pool pass as well.

## Seasonal Pool Passes

Seasonal Pool Passes will not be issued until :

- 1) Lease Renewal and Registration Agreement has been signed and returned.
- 2) The full balance of your campsite fee has been paid.

Seasonal Pool Passes are non-transferable. You must present your pool pass at the pool anytime you go (including camper swim). ADMISSION WILL NOT BE ALLOWED UNLESS YOU HAVE YOUR PASS WITH YOU.

## Campground Visitors

Anyone visiting you at your site (or a registered visitor at your campsite) MUST sign in at the office. In the past, we have had repeated occurrences with teenagers from the campground inviting friends from the pool to their campsite in the evenings. The campsite owner is responsible for ensuring any children / teenagers that are invited to their campsite are registered as visitors and must ensure their behavior is in compliance with the Campground Rules.

## Dumpsters

The dumpsters at the old house are for Campground use only. Please DO NOT leave Wood, Metal, or other objects in or around these dumpsters. These dumpsters are under video surveillance.

## PARKING

Please be reminded that you are only allowed 2 vehicles per site (NOT including golf carts). All other vehicles should be parked in the parking lot. Please do not park in grass or areas around bath houses or on the side of the roads. Please do not park on someone else's site unless you have their permission to do so. ALL visitors wishing to drive to your campsite must stop by the office and register. There is currently a \$2.00 per vehicle per day charge.
